


Pick Up Sticks



Instructions

Giant Pick Up Sticks

Only the steadiest of hands can succeed in this game of daring tension. Try to remove each stick in turn without moving any of the others. Rack up the highest score to claim the winner's crown.

What's in the Box?

30 x Wooden Sticks - each measuring 90 cm in length and 16 mm in diameter

8 x Green Sticks
7 x Yellow Sticks
7 x Blue Sticks
7 x Red Sticks
1 x Black Stick



1 Set Up

Firstly, decide on a winning score. You can play to 200, 500, 1000 or more. The higher goal you set the longer the game will take.

Secondly, write the name of all players on a piece of paper to keep score of each round.

Now hold all the Pick Up Sticks vertically with one end on the ground. Then release the sticks and let them scatter.

2 Playing the Game

Let the youngest player go first and next the player on his left and so on. Players must try to pick up the sticks one by one without moving any others.


If a player is successful in picking up a stick, they may try picking up another stick, and so forth. You might want to set a limit of how many sticks can be picked up per turn to avoid someone picking up all sticks on their first turn. This allows the game to last longer.

If a player picks up the black stick (called the Master Stick), that player is allowed to use the Master Stick to assist in removing other sticks (for example, to separate two sticks that are lying close together, or to flick off one stick that is resting on another stick). Nonetheless, the rule that the only stick allowed to move is the one the player is trying to pick up remains valid. No other stick may be used in this way.

If a player successfully picks up all the sticks, that player begins the next round and continues to play until they lose their turn or the maximum number of sticks allowed to be picked per turn is reached.

Players should add up the points from the sticks picked up after each turn. Points are assigned based on the colour of the sticks:

- Yellow - 1 point
- Green - 2 points
- Blue - 5 points
- Red - 10 points
- Black - 25 points



3 The Winner

The winner is the first player to reach the winning score set at the start of the game.
